



DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Earlier this year I mentioned to my daughter that after some 15 years of doing most jobs within amateur theatre I felt that I might "consider having a go at directing at some time in the future". Within a couple of weeks she got back to me asking if I would still be interested as Studio 61 were looking for a director for this production of Educating Rita. I was a little surprised at how quickly this opportunity came along but I'm so glad that I agreed to do it as it has been an exciting and ground breaking experience: It is Studio 61's first full length play without scripts in hand since February 2020, it is our first production in our new venue, Newhampton Arts Centre, and it introduces two new members to our team. Carol Beard has joined us as prompt and Nikki Ellis in her first acting role for Studio 61 as Rita. I was also fortunate enough to be gifted an amazingly talented cast and crew for the production.

Educating Rita, written by Willy Russell, was first performed as a stage play in 1980 and was followed by a successful film in 1983 with Julie Walters playing Rita in both productions. We have decided to keep to this time frame for our interpretation and have focused on the year 1981. This raised questions about historical accuracy and social references which were deemed unacceptable in current times but these questions generated many reminiscences and lots of laughter for both cast and crew.

So please sit back, let your minds wander back 40 years to a time when a woman's life was measured by her husband and children and see how ahead of her time Rita actually was!
